The earlier your friends send in their applications, the better chance you have of them being in your cabin. **Many campers come to camp and do not know anyone. They have a great time and meet good friends!** All campers will take part in 3 different – 50 minute program activities each day. Campers will stay in the same 3 classes during the week. **Please number all the programs,** (1 being their first choice, 2 being their second, 3 being their third preference) **Number camper's 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> choice in case their 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> choice is full.** Please take note of some programs that are limited by age. Programs are filled on a first come basis All campers of all ages will have plenty of free swim/water time each day

The age of 12 is set on sailing due to the average camper's strength and level of comfort in the water. If your camper is younger and you feel they would be fine in sailing we would be glad to discuss this before their week of camp. Please call for this waiver, 252-264-2513. All campers may climb our famous, one of a kind, rock wall during free time each day.

- **Water shoes are needed!**

- Spending money for snack shop (\$40.00 is recommended)
- Jacket for cool nights

- towels, shirts, etc.
- A hearty appetite for great food!
- **Sun block lotion** (suntan lotion)
- A spirit & attitude ready to have lots of fun and learn about God!
- **DO NOT BRING CELL PHONES TO CAMP. THANKS!**

**Dress at camp must be modest!** Cale Retreat Staff reserves the right to make the decision of what is appropriate wear. Girls must wear one-piece swimsuits or a long dark t-shirt over any two-piece or, "belly showing" swimsuit or clothing. Please, no short-shorts or rolled up shorts! The purpose of summer camp is to focus on God and have a fun time in the process. We hope you understand that all policies are made with this goal in mind. Please keep this in mind when choosing your camper's outfits for their week of camp. Flip-flop type sandals are great to wear around camp; however, your camper will be running during games, climbing a rockwall, and may be walking on cables on the ropes course, so strap on sandals or tennis shoes are needed. More pictures will be posted as soon as possible during the week.

**Your camper will NOT need the following items.** Please ask your camper if they have ANY of these items. These items should not be in any camper's possession this week. If any of these items are found they will be taken from camper or depending on the item, you will be called and the camper may be sent home.

1. Any kind of firearm or ammunition (BB, pellet, bullet, etc.) \*
2. Any kind of slingshot \*
3. Any item that shoots any kind of projectile or silly string \*
4. Matches, lighter, or anything that lights fire \*
5. Any kind of fireworks (Pop-shots, sparklers, fire crackers) \*
6. Any item that may resemble or be considered a weapon in any shape or form \*
7. Any kind of electrical music-producing equipment (CD, cassette, radio, cell phone, etc.)
8. Any kind of electronic game that uses a plug OR batteries
9. Any kind of drug, tobacco, or alcohol product \*
10. **CELL PHONES ARE NOT ALLOWED AT CAMP! If your camper cannot live without a cell phone, you may wish to consider a different camp! This is for theirs and others protection.**

Campers will be sent home if found with any of the items listed with an asterisk next to them. Please explain that there is a no tolerance rule on fighting. Anyone fighting or threatening to fight another will be sent home. Our desire is to provide a safe, relaxed, environment for your camper; safe for your camper's

body, soul, and mind. Thank you for helping us toward this goal. Feel free to call if you have any questions concerning above information.

Please read over the rules and conditions listed with your camper/s prior to leaving home for camp. It is important the campers know the rules before they arrive for their week/s. It is very important to know what to expect, and what is expected of them as much as possible. These steps help assure the best possible start for your camper while at Cale.

**Please go over these with your camper before they arrive at camp!** God is here! Reverence and respect Him. Remember, God does the impossible; He will do wonderful things in your life. Wisdom, respect, and reverence are actions of God's children.

1. This is a Christian camp. We want all to have a pleasant, safe, and healthy stay. Pleasant, safe and healthy for your mind, your soul, and your body. Therefore, disciplinary action, even to sending you home can occur with any of the following problems:
  - Smoking
  - Stealing
  - Any obscene language
  - Graffiti, writing or drawing on camp property
  - Blatant disrespect to camp staff or property
  - Fighting
  - Threatening bodily harm to another
  - Possession of illegal drugs or alcohol
  - Being outside after lights out without proper reason
  - Girls in boys' dorm or bath area
  - Boys in girls' dorm or bath area
2. Electronic equipment such as radios, TVs, tape or CD players, Game Boys or **Cell Phones** can hinder someone that might be receiving a message from God; therefore, please leave these items at home.
3. Staff housing, tractors and tool buildings are off-limits! Please respect these areas.
4. So that all may have plenty of warm water, your daily shower time is limited to 4 minutes. Please try and stick to this.
5. After lights are out, please respect others by staying in your dorm except for restroom needs.
6. Climbing trees can damage them, and you, and is not on our list of programs. Let's keep out of the trees.
7. Use all camp equipment such as chairs, tables, sport equipment and beds properly. If anything is broken, or gets broken, please tell the staff.
8. If you have any threatening challenges with anyone, tell a counselor or the camp director. We will take care of this right away!
9. Please put all trash or left over food in trash cans. The camp should be clean when you arrive, so let's respect those who will come after us by keeping it clean. Trash on the ground increases insect problems also. Give a hoot, don't pollute! ☺
10. **Please drive slowly on campground. 10 MPH is top speed! Thank you! This is an important rule** as there will be many youth running around from behind trees, and they will not be looking for you.

God can do a mighty work in your life while here at camp if you allow Him the opportunity. Most have come seeking this work of God for their life; let's respect this desire in others. The entire camp staff will be praying for you before you arrive and during your stay. Please pray for them as they seek and follow God's leading during this time of great fun, fellowship, and learning!
